



## Municipality Police

Police is a town in western Pomerania in Poland in the middle of the Ueckermünder Heide. The municipality lies on the Szczecin Lagoon and has extensive forests and a rich animal world.



The funding program is intended to support the construction of an information stand in the form of a carriage and the purchase of audio guides with multilingual content.



## Wisent Park Usedom

A nice destination for families is a visit to the bison enclosure on the island of Usedom.

Thanks to the Interreg V A funding program, the reception, ticket office and social areas with the sanitary facilities were redesigned and an information point was set up for visitors.



## Birdpark Marlow

In addition to numerous species of birds and wild animals, the Marlow Bird Park in the district of Western Pomerania-Rügen also offers feeding shows, flight and animal shows, playgrounds and restaurants. An adventure for the whole family!

## Forest Seed Kiln Jatznick

The forest seed kiln in Jatznick is responsible for carrying out the seed harvest for the state forest's own needs and for processing seeds of deciduous, coniferous and shrub types. Certified forest educators offer guided tours and project days.

As part of the Interreg V A cooperation program, an inner exhibition area with interactive modules was created, among other things.

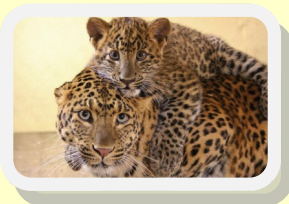
As part of this funding program, we were able to finance our path around the monastery-castle complex, which is suitable for the disabled.

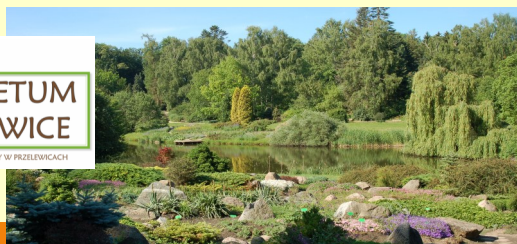

## Dendrological Garden in Przelewiec

The Dendrological Garden houses over 1200 rare and partly endangered tree and shrub species in West Pomerania in Poland. While walking, you can also meet majestic blue peacocks and mute swans. The Interreg V A funding program made it possible to renew the four kilometer long park paths with new bilingual information boards.

## Ueckermünde Zoo

The Tierpark Ueckermünde is a zoological garden with 400 native and exotic animals in spacious outdoor enclosures on the German-Polish border. In addition to the animals, visitors will find a variety of adventure playgrounds and dining options.

As part of the project "POMERANIA - nature and culture experiences" (INT 51), the adventure path is to be expanded to 1000 m<sup>2</sup> by building a walk-in aviary for parakeets. In addition, the museum barn is to be redesigned.

## Environmental Education Center in Lipie



The environmental education center in Lipie wants to promote ecological education through playful learning. The facility has a research laboratory, conference rooms, computer room, kitchen, lounge and barbecue area.

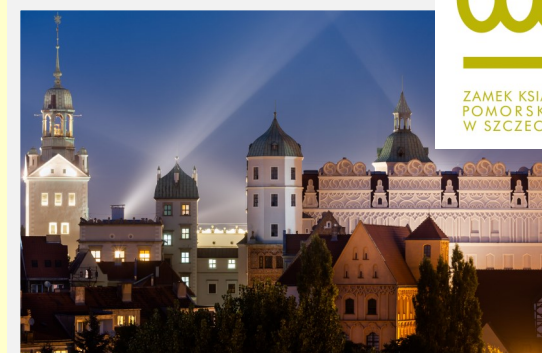
As part of the project, a German-Polish garden of nature and science will be established, consisting of a labyrinth, lookout tower, stations of colors and scents, a weight training facility, a path for the senses and educational boards.



## Pomeranian Dukes Castle in Szczecin

In the center of Szczecin is the imposing former seat of the dukes from the Pomeranian dynasty of griffins. In addition to exhibitions, there are music and film screenings, theater performances and lectures in the Renaissance castle. One of the permanent exhibitions is the witch cell with replicas of punishment and torture devices from the 16th and 17th centuries, dedicated to Sidonia von Borcke.

Among other things, an escape room was designed as part of the Interreg funding.
